

**LOW COUNTRY CLASSIC III
PARKING AND TAILGATING GUIDELINES**

Thank you for your support of Bulldog Athletics. The following guidelines have been developed to aide in your comfort while attending the **Low Country Classic III**. Please review and abide by them. Please follow the map attached to understand where to park.

The **Burke Lot** is reserved for VIP and other special guests. The VIP pass must be displayed to access this parking lot.

If you have a S.T.A.T.E. Club parking pass, you will be allowed to park on a first come, first served basis in the **Hagood Lot**. S.T.A.T.E. Club members with RV passes may park their RVs in the **RV Parking Lot** across the street from the stadium on Hagood Avenue.

Fans with SC State Season Parking Passes may park in the paved parking area at the **Alumni Center Parking Lot** and on the north side of the **Holliday Alumni Center**. This privilege is allowed on a first come, first served basis.

SC State Season Parking Passes and S.T.A.T.E. Club parking passes will also be honored at the **Lockwood Field** and **MUSC** or **C Lot** on Fishburne Street.

Fans without any of the passes mentioned above may pay for parking at the **Lockwood Field** or at the **MUSC** or **C Lot** for \$15.00. RVs without passes mentioned above may pay for parking at the **MUSC** or **C Lot** for \$150.00.

Parking Passes must be displayed at all times. Vehicles parked in restricted areas without the proper pass are subject to being towed at the owner's expense.

Please observe and obey the parking attendants when parking your vehicle.

All parking lots will close at 11:00 p.m.

ABSOLUTELY NO CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN AREAS OUTSIDE THE SAFE ZONE AREAS AS OUTLINED ON THE MAP ATTACHED. ABSOLUTELY NO UNDER AGE DRINKING!

Please, no loud or inappropriate music or signage. Also, no artificial noise makers are allowed inside the stadium.

No tents larger than a 10 x 10 allowed.

No trailers are allowed with vehicles.

Please clean up your area. Dispose of trash in trash containers or take it away and properly dispose of it when you leave the area.
